Do you have blogs that you frequent on a regular basis that relate to your topic? Talk to the blog owner about sharing links. Add a link on your site to your favorite blog, and then ask them if they would be willing to put a link to your site on their blog. Remember, it costs nothing to ask!

Comment, Comment, Comment!

As you visit forums, blogs, and websites relating to your blog's topic, leave meaningful comments. Most of these websites will allow you to place a link to your blog in your signature line. If you make your comments meaningful, not just promotional, readers will want to know more of your expertise and will visit the link in your signature. Just remember not to spam these websites with promotional posts. That will rarely bring traffic to your site, and overly promotional posts will often get you banned from the site.

Building backlinks is free and simple, provided you know where to look. Try each of these tips to build links to your blog. Soon you will see traffic increases, and hopefully income increases as well!
